## **Christmas Trees**

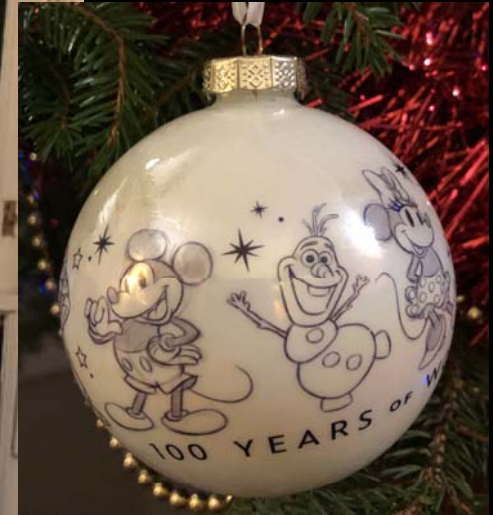
The Christmas trees were displayed from 9th December.
